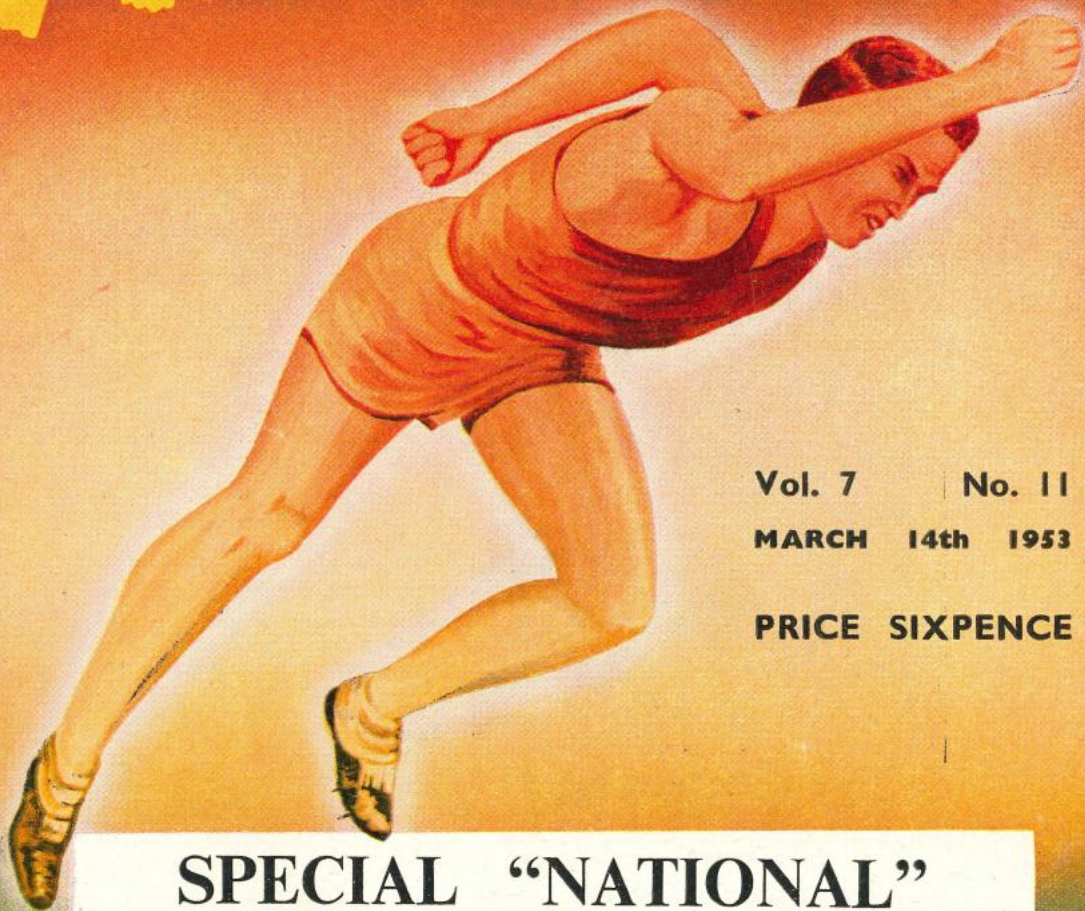

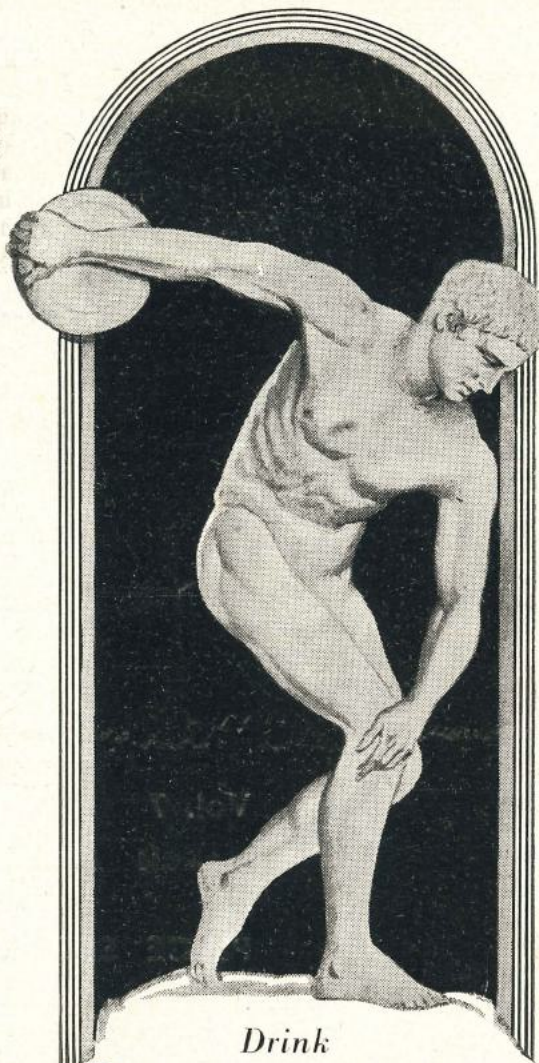

EVERY SATURDAY — SIXPENCE

AFTER the National Cross-Country Championship at Reading last Saturday, some of the Midland enthusiasts were inclined to take me to task over my remarks in this column, but I stand by what I said and my forecast was not far out in any of the three races, except for the inexplicable failure of the brilliant Ilford youths.

I stated last week that Birchfield must have an excellent chance of success on their Midland Championship form, though with the *standard* in the Midlands still rather low, it was difficult to give a true estimate of the value of this performance.

As it was, Birchfield won and won well, though in fairness to Bolton it must be said that if the Northerners had run up to their true form they would probably have turned the tables. To take but five of their team—Norris 11th, Berry 23rd, Saunders 47th, Williams 103rd and Eastham 211th. I do not profess to know the reason for this sorry showing, but I doubt if Birchfield will catch them on such a day again. However, I fully anticipate Birchfield being a power in the country game for many years to come, which is all to the good.

Several readers seem to think that it is unfair to select the National team on one showing, pointing out that the usually consistent Norris is out of the team, whereas a comparative "unknown" in Foster is in. I should certainly like to see selection based on more than one race, but as it happens, Norris is included with Foster, who must be considered unlucky, first reserve.

TO-DAY'S main events are the Oxford v. Cambridge clash at the White City, at which some outstanding performances may well be accomplished, the Ilford Road Relay and the Dorchester-Poole Road Relay, for which 15 teams have entered from as far afield as Portsmouth, Aylesford, Bristol and Walton.

THE "NATIONAL"

At Reading, March 7th

THE three National races were held over a fast, though somewhat hilly course, at Caversham Park, Reading. Except for the unexpected failure of Bolton to reproduce their normal form, and the amazing flop of the brilliant Ilford youths' team, the racing went very much to form.

Gordon Pirie was in great form and even if Hesketh and Eyre had been in the field, I don't think either would have lived with him. Frank Sando, as I fully anticipated, had not properly recovered from his Southern duel with Pirie, but was able to shake off the attentions of Gray in the last 150 yards, the latter being very tired at the finish after battling it out with the Aylesford runner most of the way.

The fine victory of Birchfield is discussed on another page, but it can be said that they were always in a good position, though behind Bolton at halfway. From then on Birchfield went up, and Bolton dropped away badly. Victoria Park had probably not quite recovered from their own national championship race the week before.

The first seven, plus Norris (Bolton) and Peters (Essex Beagles), who is nominated as captain, have been selected to represent England in the International at Paris next Saturday. Foster, Walker and Hardy are the reserves. It is a good team and should do well, though one cannot help regretting the absence of Hesketh and Eyre, who would

have been a tower of strength if fit and well.

P. B. Driver was a good winner from tiny Johnny Wild and may well be another Gordon Pirie in the making. Whether intentional or not, his arm action is remarkably similar to Pirie's and several people noticed how easily one could be taken for the other at a distance.

Essex Beagles and South London confirmed my opinion, stated last week, that the Southern juniors were stronger this year, and finished at the head of affairs as they did in the Southern. This time the Beagles managed to make their victory more conclusive, despite Knight's loss of form which brought him home some $\frac{1}{4}$ minute behind his clubmate, Douglas.

Reeve, of Southend, was a real surprise packet, though I had heard a whisper that they had "a good one" for this race. After being passed by Allen of Godiva, Reeve came again in the last 100 yards and just got home to win by two seconds.

Ilford's failure can largely be accounted for by the dropping of Shuttleworth from 6th in the Southern to 132nd here, and of Holdstock from 16th to 112th. N. F. Everard, of Blackheath, also dropped from 5th in the Southern to 109th this time. The Northern and Midland boys were more consistent and Sheffield, with 3 in 18 and 4 in 40, were good winners.
